Ms. Racheal Ankrah-Fosu is a 23 year veteran of Wall Street's FinTech industry and a recognized Executive in that field. She is an entrepreneur and a passionate philanthropist. As of 2019, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu brought her Information Technology Executive Management expertise to \$4B powerhouse Broadridge having responsibility for Global Information Technology Strategy and Business Development. In that role, she constantly looked to apply emerging technologies such as Cloud Migration, Data & Analytics Optimization, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence to Broadridge's technology suite to deliver cheaper, better and faster. Ms. Ankrah-Fosu focused on developing strategic partnerships with cutting edge technology providers, Business Presidents and C-suites to evolve Broadridge's FinTech posture via an aggressive technology enabled strategic roadmap.

Prior to joining Broadridge, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu moved the New York Stock Exchange from measuring mission critical stock trading applications in minute increments to ultra-low latency microsecond increments across 11+ global trading exchanges. Notably she created and led a global, ultra-low latency application performance and capacity management practice in support of billions of dollars in trading revenue. Her role at NYSE was at the heart of ensuring that NYSE trading critical systems could handle high volume trading days and record-breaking IPOs like the largest ever Global IPO, Alibaba.

Ms. Ankrah-Fosu is a graduate of Oxford University's Saïd Business School, Oxford England and is an Oxford Forte Fellow. She has been featured as an Inspirational Woman by Oxford's Saïd Business School. She obtained her undergraduate degrees from Rutgers University and was named to the Rutgers African-American Alliance Alumni Hall of Fame in 2018. Whilst at Rutgers, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu co-developed, marketed and taught an entrepreneurial program for the Rutgers Cooperative Schools designed for at-risk youth. Upon graduation from Rutgers, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu was recruited to Andersen Consulting (Accenture) after which she subsequently joined the New York Stock Exchange's technology arm in 1999 where she remained until 2016. She has been awarded the honor of Professional Woman of The Year by the National Association of Professional Women and Distinguished Leader by the International Women's Leadership Association. A child of Monrovia, Liberia, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu emigrated to the US at the age of 14 already an 11th grader.

As a corporate citizen, Ms. Ankrah-Fosu is active in her community and has actively helped raise money to help Africans cope with the spread of HIV. She mentors young men and women and is passionate about teaching financial literacy to under-privileged youth. She initiated the Dominic K. A. Fosu Visionary Fund in honor of her recently deceased husband in 2016. The fund offers educational funding assistance to a visionary student and has given out \$25,000 to award recipients. Ms. Ankrah-Fosu is a co-founder of a grief support group that aims to provide support to members of her church, Calvary Baptist Church and the surrounding Morristown NJ community. Of most import, she is focused on being the best of Mom to her two sons, following her dreams of being an inspirational speaker, global technology innovative leader and setting a strong example of perseverance and success despite adversity for her sons.

Ms. Racheal Ankrah-Fosu is currently on book tour for her recently published memoir, "Hold Me 'til my River Jordan", a biopic memoir dedicated to emotional release for caregivers. She is on a one year sabbatical from Corporate America as she pursues her community service passion as the Founder and President of the Ruth & Isaac project, a non-profit focused on illuminating the silent plight of the caregiving experience.
